- What is the Measure "D" Subcommittee?
  - In 2001 the voting population within the BMKCSD moved forward with a parcel tax specifically earmarked for maintaining waterfront assets within the District and to support the Measure E + F Bond spends from a maintenance standpoint
  - Oversight group of BMKCSD residents is made up of:
    - Two (2) each from North + South Lagoon, and Creek appointed by the BMKCSD Board
    - Two (2) BMKCSD Board Members
- The Measure "D" Subcommittee reviews projects, budgets, and financials specific to the Measure D Parcel Tax on a semi-annual basis in November and May.
- The Measure "D" Subcommittee will vote to move budgets and projects to the BMKCSD Board for final approval and as such Measure "D"s actions are advisory.

Bahama Reef boat ramp dock

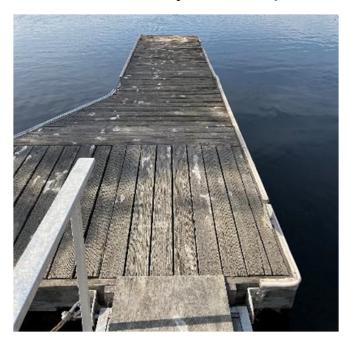
- Anticipated to be completed by June 30, 2021: ~\$25,000
- 25 30 year lifespan with typical maintenance

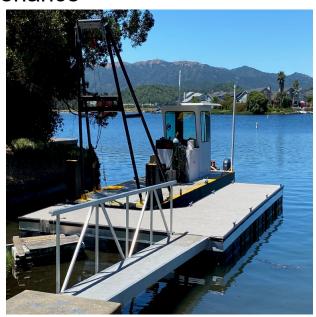

- 25 30 year lifespan with typical maintenance

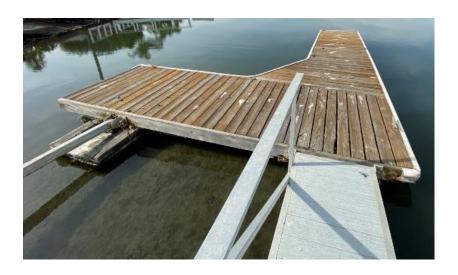

- 25 30 year lifespan with typical maintenance



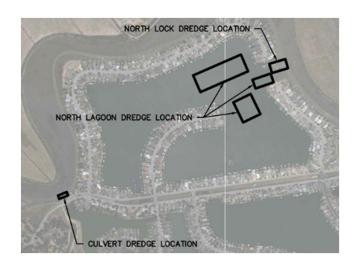
- Completed / In Process Projects
   WQ Issues in Fall of 2020
  - Started in the North Lagoon and spread to the South Lagoon
  - BMKCSD engaged a biologist due to the unclassified nature and unknown species of bloom
  - Cautionary notices sent to residents / lagoon restrictions and advisories undertaken
  - Lab results revealed no "red tide" after multiple testing events
  - Biological evaluation ultimately determined brine shrimp within the lagoon ecosystem and advisories + restrictions lifted



# Completed / In Process Projects North Lagoon Dredging

- Contract issued to Lind Marine (Petaluma) in 2020 for \$675,000
- Work to be undertaken in 2021 dredge season
- Issues at DMMS with endangered species resulted in delays to project due to regulatory agency interactions
- May 2021 WQ Discharge Permit from DMMS delayed
- In negotiations with Contractor to push project to 2022 including additional dredge yardage

### 2. Ongoing Waterways Projects / Activities

- Water Quality Monitoring (Biological / Chemistry)
- Levee Maintenance and Monitoring

### 3. Deferred Projects / Critical (Likely 2023/2024)

- Why?
  - North Lagoon Dredging at \$675k+, DMMS + Soft Costs has project at \$800-900k in total
  - Measure D Reserves and funds available as of April 2021 are ~\$1.14M
  - Cash flows from Measure D Reserves averages ~\$200k per fiscal year

### 1. Proposed / Planned Projects

- South Lock Creek Float ~ \$50,000
- Hudson Park Fencing and Vegetation Mgmt.
  - Cost shared with operating ~ \$12,500 Measure D Portion
- North Lock Hydraulic Repairs \$TBD
- DMMS Annual Vegetation Mgmt. ~\$25,000
- North Lagoon Dredging (2022/2023, ~\$900k)

### 2. Proposed 2021-2022 Budget

- Measure D has a built in 2% per annual adjustment
- Not including the aged infrastructure and demands thereof each year costs generally exceed the annual adjustment
- 2021/2022 Budget projected spending reserves of approximate 36%
- Goal is to maintain critical infrastructure and services/Defer some infrastructure and cap projects that can take the delay

### Overview of District Actions to Date Regarding Funding Needs

#### Capital Asset Program 2045

- Engineering and Facilities Management has estimated Capital needs for aging infrastructure through 2045.
- Ad-hoc 2045 Capital Asset Planning Group meeting monthly.
- Seeking assistance from professional polling firms.
- Financial advisor has provided cash flow analysis projections.
- Measure "D" funds are not sufficient for Capital Projects and needs for the BMKCSD.

### 2. Proposed Projects without Funding

 We have identified ~\$18M of future capital and infrastructure needs above and beyond what Measure D can undertake

• For context in 2045 the North Lock will be 75 years old and the South Lock will be 60 years old other marine assets and infrastructure within the District will need significant capital for continued use.

### 3. Other Items of Interest

#### South Lagoon Levee

- BMKCSD is aware of significant activities occurring on the South Lagoon Levee
- More complaints into the office on fishing from the levee and reports of people moving the riprap protection to create access points
- An inspection of the levee noting the areas of disturbance and extent of repairs required will be conducted and shared with District counsel
- BMKCSD counsel is working on a letter to SCC counsel regarding damage
- Note: The BMKCSD does not have any ownership interest in the South Lagoon Levee, only an affirmative obligation to maintain
