IX. Routine Waterways Maintenance Update

A. Navigation Lock Maintenance

We have had a set back and working with a new representative from DST for the limit switch relocation. We will be establishing the highest hightide mark to keep the switches out of the water, I have a meeting with DST Monday.

B. Buoy and Navigation Markers

We are testing new buoys caps and researching a new buoy as we have a few that keep flopping over even with a counterweight

C. Aquatic Vegetation/ water quality

We have been working with Biologist as to the application of the new algae treatment (Muck Biotics) we have purchased the product and will be working a schedule to start treatment. We are also looking at the diffusers which need to be updated. The oldest system which was put in paddle boat was installed in 2005/2006 the system in sunset lagoon was installed 13/14. There was some concern speaking with the manufacturer the system we currently have has a 1/3 horse power piston is and that is no longer available. There were some deficiencies in the maintenance, however, even with deficiencies it is estimated that the life of each unit is only 6-9 years with optimal care. I will be submitting the biologist recommendations next month.
