A. North Lagoon Dredging Permit

We are still awaiting the soil sampling results that will then be presented to the DMMO in November.

We are working on a schedule with Global for the dive inspection. We are also trying to get the cathodic protection vendor onsite at the same time.

President Lattanzio asked to check with District engineers on the coatings project for the lock doors.

- E. Welding to South Lock Doors

Two of the doors on the south lock need to have some welding soen to the pivot point of the doors. Working with Energy Expert International (EEI) and seeking additional vendors to complete the welding. The cost for completing should be within the DM's spending limit.

X. Routine Waterways Maintenance Update

A. Navigation Lock Maintenance

EEI have been onsite and completed a monthly maintenance on both lock and the hydrogen tanks have been replenished at both locks. EEI is on board to coming onsite every three months to do the lock maintenance and record and submit report back to the DM.

B. Buoy and Navigation Markers

All buoys will need to be inspected and cleaned. There are buoys on hand should we have to replace some. Director Retz noted he is working on mockup of a buoy.

C. Aquatic Vegetation/ water quality

We are scheduling the next muck biotic application for both lagoons. Residents have noted continued algae growth in some areas.

D. Diffuser Systems in South Lagoon Scheduling LakeTech to come onsite and do an overview of how the diffusers are working and submit report.

B Novato Creek Cleanup

Director Retz noted the need to work with residents and get volunteers to do clean ups on the creek and possibly use the work vessel for removal of the debris. He noted there are a number of dilapidated docks and possibly that resident is unable to keep up with the maintenance and

creating a navigation hazard.

C. Develop a community feedback survey to gage community concerns Director Retz noted that it would be beneficial to do a survey of the community and what they feel is important and what the board should prioritize and projects of interest.

D. Community Center commercial stove replacement

The board discussed the concerned brought back from club members about the need to replace the stove. Ernie Ganas noted that replacement would need to eb in-kind that stove is no longer able to be serviced and when the pilot lights go out you can smell the gas. In the past residents have called the fire department and though there was a gas leak, and the gas was shut off instead of just lighting the pilot.
